Finally, two months before the Festival opening, two themes clearly took over: **DEATH** and **ANARCHY**.

DEATH is linked to the 50th anniversary of Roy Hart's sudden violent death on May 18, 1975. "The most powerful, tragic and disturbing *MAGICAL* event I have ever experienced in my life." EP

ANARCHY is a late-comer, though always in the background, with no claim to mythological limelight - indeed, is it a myth? A book brought it to the fore: *Au voleur! Anarchisme et philosophie* (translated as *Stop Thief!*) - by Catherine Malabou, translation 2023. A first-class *ethical* reflection on why Anarchy is rarely credited for some of the best thinking in the last, say, 100 years. Political, in Malabou's case. In ours: critical. Artists are thieves and Anarchy a favorite resort: Picasso, Artaud, Castellucci, so many others.



UPDATES - REMINDERS - NOTES

REMINDER. The Festival was born in the 1980s, with **James Hillman**, founder of archetypal psychology. I confess that until now I hadn't considered the relationship between anarchy and archetype, both of which are based on the Greek radical *arkhé*: foundation/authority. I also agree with Hillman that the richness of C.G. Jung's notion of archetype has lost some of its cultural and mytho-poetic genius, probably due to its popularity and scientific-clinical reductions. With the title of the last compilation of his complete works, Hillman makes a clear statement: **From Types to Images**. Return to images and myths: we've wandered enough through typological catalogues.

NOTE. The crossovers and differences in approach between Catherine Malabou (Anarchism) and James Hillman (Archetypes) are fascinating, especially as regards the role of ideas, particularly ethical ones, and their

respective and very different ways of "ideating" (ideation, a Hillmanian term: working on, creating or flushing out ideas.) We performers have to act-out on all this. One proposal is to do it literally, with *chiaroscuro* lighting à la Caravaggio.

REMINDER. This is a thirteen-day residential festival devoted to the links between **PRACTICE and THEORY**. Practical workshops in the mornings; vocal and singing work in the afternoons; lectures, master classes and performances evenings.

Note. Xavier Papaïs will be joining us - a connoisseur and appreciator of Anarchy. We have invited **Sonu Shamdasani**, historian of psychology; **Véronique Taconet**, to talk about her journey through madness, **Delphina Fabrini**, who certainly knows 'her' Caravaggio - among others.

Note. Participants are advised to chose and bring a working text, learnt by heart. The work starts with that choice. Check **ADVICE and EXAMPLES**
